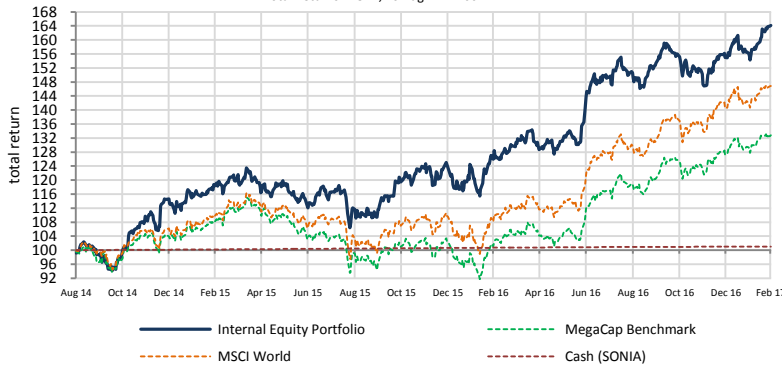


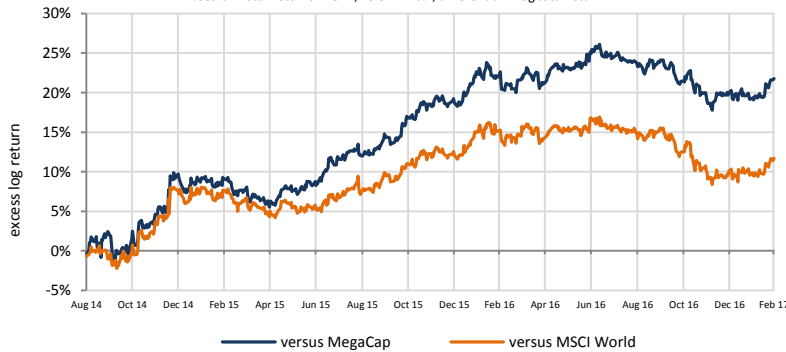
Internal Equity Portfolio Performance

The Internal Equity Strategy is a low turnover, concentrated portfolio of large cap equities, listed on developed market exchanges. Our investment strategy is to identify high quality businesses with sustainable business models that are able to compound shareholder returns over a full business cycle. We seek to buy these businesses with these characteristics at valuations that are attractive on an absolute and relative basis.

The portfolio is constructed to generate a total return that is in line with our Statement of Investment Principles (SIP) while controlling exposure to fundamental business risk.

February Performance Commentary

The Portfolio returned c.5.6% in February, ahead of the MSCI World at c.3.9%.

In terms of attribution of the relative outperformance during the month, the main contributors were the portfolio's overweight exposures to consumer staples and information technology, its underweight to energy and materials and the outperformance of the portfolio's staples and industrial holdings versus the benchmark. The relative underperformance of the portfolio's consumer discretionary and financials holdings was the main drag on the overall return for the month.

Colgate, Unilever and Johnson & Johnson were notable contributors to performance, during the month. London Stock Exchange and Richemont were the only detractors.

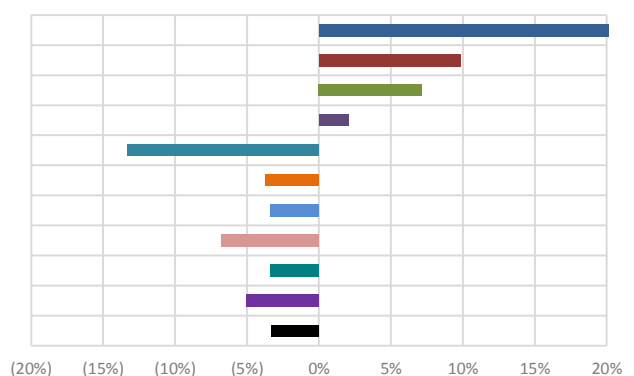

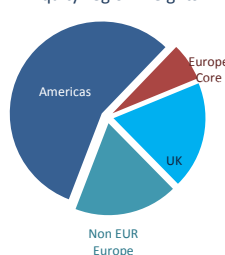
Internal Equity sector weights MSCI World



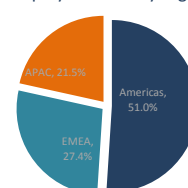

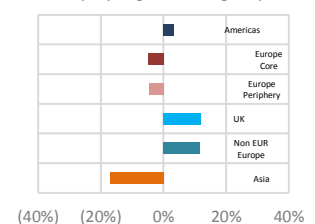
I. Equity region weights
